Bank of Baroda joins the 'Swachhata Hi Seva 2018' movement by inaugurating a Biogas Plant at their BKC office

October 3, 2018, Mumbai: Bank of Baroda inaugurated "Wet Garbage Processing Unit" (Bio Gas plant) at Baroda Sun Tower to support the government's 'Swachhata Hi Sewa 2018' movement. Mr. P S Jayakumar, MD and CEO and K B Gupta, General Manager, Bank of Baroda inaugurated the biogas plant at the bank's Corporate Office in Bandra Kurla Complex (BKC), Mumbai.

The Biogas plant will decompose 500 kg of wet garbage/canteen waste per day from bank's corporate office in BKC. This unit shall convert wet waste into biogas as well as manure. Further it will be used for cooking and agriculture purposes. The plant is capable of producing approximately 30 kgs of biogas per day. The established unit is based on NISARGRUNA Biogas Plant model developed by Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC).

Commenting on the occasion, Bank of Baroda's MD and CEO, Mr. P S Jayakumar, said, "We, at Bank of Baroda, believe that sanitation has strong inter-linkages with key socio-economic factors. We trust that this unit will not only help us facilitate good health, but also promote a sustainable community and effective waste management. By establishing this 'Wet Garbage Processing Unit' we are pleased to extend our support to the government's 'Swachhata Hi Sewa 2018' initiative."
